Construction to replace the Clackamas River (Carver) Bridge begins in May!

After several years of planning and public outreach, construction is scheduled to begin in mid- to late May. You're invited to join the project manager and contractor to learn more about the project, including the construction schedule, efforts made to reduce noise and disruptions for area residents, and design of the new bridge.

PUBLIC MEETING on the CLACKAMAS RIVER BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

The bridge will be replaced at its present location. A temporary detour bridge will be built next to the current bridge to allow people access through the area during construction. Because of the limited amount of time work is allowed in the Clackamas River (only 6-8 weeks per year) and the need for careful construction staging to allow traffic to continue throughout the project, the new bridge is scheduled to be completed and opened in fall 2014. The new two-lane bridge will have sidewalks and bike lanes on both sides.
